The up side

- The jobs continue and the overall appearance of the site is good.

- Scouters are booking activities through Rock and River
- As a trial throughout the summer season a permanently tented area will be erected consisting of a number of patrol tents, a dining shelter and some cookers. This area will be available for hire. Details will be released soon from the site office.

The down side

- There seems to be some misunderstanding over Criminal Records Bureau Clearance. All adults i.e. those over 18 years of age need to be CRB cleared before they can camp at Tawd Vale. This includes ex-members of the movement and any helpers who are brought along.
- A number of craft have been used on the Delph and have not displayed a registration sticker. All boats owned and operated by Scouts must be registered and display the sticker before they can be used on the Delph. John Foskett has a copy of the regulations available in the Warden s office if a Scouter wishes to read them.
