The 'up' side.

A recommendation is to be put forward to the County Executive that the site charges remain the same for the ensuing year. This is partly because the shower block is proving reasonably economical to run and the increase in fees for 2003 were to help to offset that cost.

Both the Mersey Moot and the Ormskirk Gathering took place on site.

The 'Wee House ' has been refurbished

Mr. Guy has removed his equipment from the site.

There has been an increase in the site income over the past quarter.

The 'down' side.

The large events held damage a number of areas on site.

The event organisers must ensure that the site is left in a reasonable condition and equipment returned and/or reported as damaged.

There is a major problem that has been identified concerning the Cub Field Toilet Block. This block will be closed from now until the beginning of the next season so that a survey and the necessary work can be carried out.

The number of cars entering the site will have to be limited at the beginning and end of large events. 300 cars arriving within half an hour is proving a problem.

Planning permission has been sought for a Microlight airfield at Taylors Farm with over 3000 movements a year. The impact on the site would be immense and a letter of objection listing a number of concerns has been sent.

The shower block doors are de-laminating and will need replacing very soon.

The next committee meeting is on November 12th.
