MERSEYMOOT 9TH – 11TH SEPTEMBER 2011.

Please find enclosed, booking forms for completion and a copy of the rules for your retention for this years Moot. May I emphasise the importance of booking early, due to the increasing popularity of the Moot, as numbers will be restricted this year.

I would like to remind you, as a leader, of your responsibilities with regard to the behaviour of your Unit, especially in relation to the consumption of alcohol. As you may well know this has caused considerable heartache in previous years, and at one stage this resulted in a total alcohol ban. Whilst we would not like to see people's enjoyment curtailed in anyway, we insist that alcohol should not be consumed in public areas of the campsite.

The Campsite rules regarding alcohol consumption must be adhered to.

No alcohol should be consumed by any person under the age of 18 years. If people over that age feel they must have a drink, they must confine themselves to their own campsite and behave with some decorum.

Please also be aware that Merseymoot is for **Explorer Scouts, Network, Ranger Guides and Young Leaders**, and that children and young people below the age of 14 **must not camp overnight**.

Please read the rules on the booking form, before signing it; **don't forget to get it countersigned by your Guide Commissioner or appropriate Scout Explorer or Network Commissioner.**
Please note that you must also comply with your organisations overnight/weekend regulations.

Please ensure that the forms are completed correctly and clearly – if not they will be returned and this may cause delays in booking your places at this years Moot

If after reading this, you still want to take part in this years Moot, return your completed and signed booking forms as soon as possible to avoid disappointment. **Late entries will not be accommodated.** Once your booking forms have been received, more information, permission forms and health forms will follow at a later date. (If you have not heard anything by 1st September – please contact me.)
