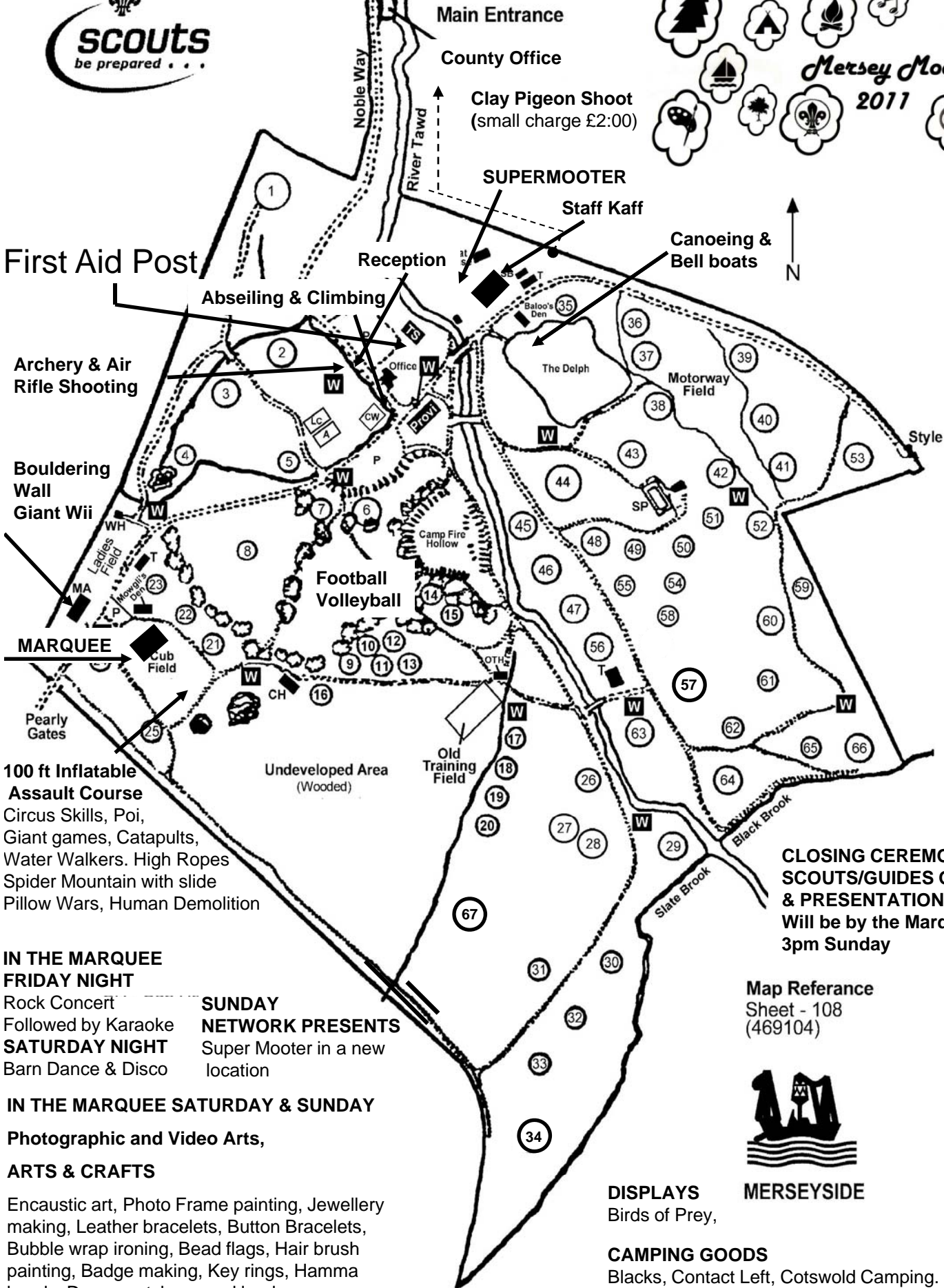

TAWD VALE: - Merseyside's own County Campsite is near Ormskirk, Lancs. From the M6 motorway (junction27) take A5209 west for 6-7 miles, just beyond Newburgh. From Liverpool, leave A59 soon after Burscough, taking A5209 east about 3 miles towards Parbold. OS sheet 108 GR. 470 098. Tel 01695 722866

CAR PARKING: - is just beyond the main camp entrance. Please bring as few cars as possible and park as directed. Sorry but tractor-trailers are no longer available to move kit from the car park.

LITTER: - please ensure you use the sacks and bins provided. Before leaving please clear your campsite and take all rubbish to the skip provided on the car park

BEFORE LEAVING CAMP: - you must arrange to have your site inspected by one of the Tawd Vale staff.
