

## **FOR YOUR RETENTION.**

### **MERSEYMOOT 9<sup>TH</sup> – 11<sup>TH</sup> SEPTEMBER 2011.**

All units **MUST** have a Leader on site for the whole weekend, this Leader will be held responsible for his/her Units behaviour at all times during the Moot. In the event of a Leader not being able to be present for the whole weekend, a Leader from another unit **MUST** be asked to stand in. This must be agreed beforehand and the substitute Leader should be known to those in his/her charge. This must be notified to the Booking Secretary prior to the weekend.

No alcohol should be consumed by any person under the age of 18 years.

Abusive behaviour or language will not be tolerated.

Young people under the age of 14 - MUST NOT camp overnight.

**All campers must complete a health form, this includes Leaders, Service Teams and Instructors. These forms are to be handed in to the Booking Secretary on arrival on Friday evening.**

LEADERS WILL BE ASKED TO SIGN A DECLARATION AGREEING THAT THEIR UNITS WILL ABIDE BY THESE RULES.  
NON-COMPLIANCE WITH THESE RULES MAY MEAN THAT THE WHOLE UNIT WILL BE ASKED TO LEAVE THE SITE.

### **LEADERS RESPONSIBILITY AT THIS WEEKEND:**

Look after your own unit.

Ensure the Unit stays within the Rules of the Moot.

Know the whereabouts of your Unit from Midnight onwards.

Ensure all are back on their own site by 2.00 am.

No alcohol should be consumed by any person under the age of 18 years.

Alcohol, if consumed, is confined to your **OWN** campsite and in line with the Campsite Rules.

Ensure that each member of your unit is issued and wear their wristbands – on their wrists and that the bands should be visible at all times.  
Anyone found not wearing a wrist band, could result in the whole unit being sent home.

All visitors at the weekend should sign in on arrival, and sign out on departure from site. Please ensure that any visitors must be off site by 6pm on the day of arrival.
